




Topeka High School Trends Over Time


Total Students Over Time




Student Teacher Ratio Over Time



Topeka High School Free and Reduced Lunch Assistance

Topeka High School is ranked 6th out of 0 ranked schools in Kansas, for total students on lunch assistance.

The percentage of Topeka High School students on free and reduced lunch assistance (67.5%) is significantly higher than the state average of **43.1%**. This may indicate that the area has a higher level of poverty than the state average.

Students at a participating school may purchase a meal through the National School Lunch Program. Families with incomes between 130% and 185% of the federal poverty level are eligible for reduced price meals. Schools may not charge more than 40¢ for reduced-price lunches, nor more than 30¢ for reduced-price breakfasts. Students from families with incomes at or below 130% of the federal poverty level are eligible for free meals.

For 2014, a family of two needs to make an annual income below \$20,449 to be eligible for free meals or below \$29,100 for reduced price meals. A family of four needs to make an annual income below \$31,005 for free meals or \$44,122 for reduced price meals.



Principal or Youth Club Director Support	Principal or Youth Club Director completes and signs support statement.
Registration & Participation	A) Two or more teachers/advisers from a school or youth club register and complete project according to Challenge Rules OR B)One teacher/adviser teaches Lead2Feed to an entire grade level or youth organization, registers and completes a project
Project Submission	Groups from participating school or site must submit completed project(s)
Two years in the program and beyond	Certified after projects from 2 teachers/advisers or more OR participation from a full grade level completed for two years in a row. Certification stays active as long as school or site participates each year.
