E-RATE

Let us alleviate your E-Rate burden!

The Schools and Libraries Program (E-Rate) was transformed these past three years. Major E-Rate changes became effective with the 2016-2017 funding year and affected all school districts. Not only were previous policies altered (e.g. discount levels, eligible services, available funding, voice services phase-out), the process has undergone a total overhaul. The program is in the process of changing to an online service that includes new forms and new communication methods (EPC portal); essentially it is no longer the program we have become accustomed to.

We've been tracking changes to the program as USAC has made the information available. Let Smoky Hill Education Service Center guide you through all of the changes in the E-Rate program so you will have more time to devote to your other duties!

We are a Kansas based educational service center that has worked successfully with E-Rate since its inception. Our goal is to ensure your organization receives the maximum benefit from E-Rate while limiting your time commitment.


Not only will we work with you to be sure you meet E-Rate requirements, we will:

- Act as a resource to help you with the most current guidelines and eligible services
- · Follow up with your staff to be sure forms are certified in a timely manner
- Review current services with you and your staff to determine which ones are eligible for reimbursement
- · Discuss your "wish list" for the upcoming school year
- Guide you through the Fair and Competitive Bidding Process
- Work with you and/or your staff to gather the necessary paperwork needed for forms filing
- Oversee and assist with filing all forms essential to apply for vendor discounts and/or USAC reimbursement including Forms 470, 471, 472, 486, and 500
- Retain copies of the E-Rate forms as required by USAC
- Continue to follow the year's progression until it is complete
- Provide assistance with site visits, selective reviews, and audits
- · Base fees on the amount reimbursed to the district

As the 2018-2019 funding year unfolds, we anticipate that we will see additional modifications to procedures and regulations. With this in mind, we will continue to monitor the program and keep you apprised of changes that will affect your district.


