

GET AN "A" IN VOTING!

The upcoming November election may be one of the most important elections in recent memory for our schools and the students of Kansas. We as educators have a civic responsibility to 'Walk our Talk' and show future voters one way to become civically engaged.

With that in mind, a planning meeting with staff members from KAESA, KASB, USA, KNEA, KARSP, KanSPRA, Game on for Kansas Schools, and a number of Kansas superintendents was held to help develop a voter registration initiative called, "Get an 'A' in Voting." The purpose of the "Get an 'A' in Voting" initiative is to provide a number of simple, easy to use resources that Kansas education leaders can use to help increase voter registration and voter turnout in Kansas elections.
