What is Smoky Hill?

History...

Smoky Hill Education Service Center was founded on July 1, 1990, in Salina, Kansas, to benefit member school districts and



educational institutions with **services and cost savings**. In 2004, SHESC expanded to 9th Street in the former Franklin Elementary School building. Today, the center also maintains a satellite location in Hays, Kansas. The center serves more than **50 school districts** today across **25 counties**, serving **2,700 teachers and administrators** responsible for the education of more than **31,000 Kansas students**.

How We Work...

Membership or participation in SHESC is voluntary, but the Kansas State Department of Education encourages contacting service centers for assistance.

The service center can do work for Kansas school districts that is simply too expensive or difficult for them because of limitations in time, expertise, or personnel. Sometimes, it may still be faster, easier, or less expensive to have the service center do work currently completed by individual districts.

But Smoky Hill Education Service Center does more than serve member school districts.
